

Kendriya Vidyalayas in NCR keep 20,000 seats for Class I

New Delhi: Over one lakh students will be admitted in Class I across 1,090 Kendriya Vidyalayas, including around 20,000 students in 80 KVAs in the national capital region. Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has announced the admission schedule for 2013-14 academic year and the registration process will start from Friday. The last date for issuing and submission of forms is March 10.

There will be no admission test up to Class VIII and the admissions will be based on the priority category system. Moreover, the KVAs will, as per the Supreme Court's guidelines, reserve 25% seats for the economically weaker section (EWS) category without any further sub-division. If applications cross number of seats, lottery system will be followed in each category.

Dinesh Kumar, additional commissioner (academics), KVS, said, "Major change this year is the 25% reservation for EWS category provided under RTE Act. Other process remains more or less same and admissions from Class II onwards will depend on vacancy status of each school in that particular class. At entry level, which is Class I, KVAs will ad-

mit around one lakh students this year across India."

The 80 KVAs in Delhi and NCR will admit 15,000 to 20,000 students in Class I. The sample form is available on the website. It can be downloaded, filled and submitted at the respective schools. But for admission into Class II onwards,

parents need to contact the schools individually for vacancy status," said Kumar.

The list for Class I will be released on March 18 and the admission process will go on till March 25. The list of short-listed candidates for Class II onwards (except for Class XI) will be declared on April 18.
